<u>Technical description</u> of the solution, include features, new inventions, advantages and improvements to the existing solutions (if the case) (300 words, ½ page),

<u>Application areas and benefits</u> (who are the users, where it can be applied, cross-disciplinarity). Include also the benefits for the users and the society. (300 words, ½ page)

<u>Impact and market</u> – what is the unique value proposition, market value, scalability. Include a short market analysis and competition advantages. (300 words, ½ page)





Evaluation Criteria:

The proposals will be evaluated by a panel of experts based on the following criteria:

	Evaluation Criteria
Writing	Demonstration of the understanding of field selected
	Assessment of challenges and how these will be addressed
	Quality of the project/work (writing, easy to follow, design, graphics)
Innovation	Why is the idea innovative? - Degree of innovation assessment
	Originality and creativity (innovative thinking, thinking outside the box)
	Soundness of the concept, and credibility of the proposed solution - Can it be implemented tomorrow?
	Market potential showed/described
Sustainability	Show how the idea will improve the field/society. What are the benefits of your idea/research?
	Show how the idea be managed, delivered and sustained?
	Show the impact of the impact and scalability
	Contribution to achievement of UN sustainable development goals
